

Welcome to the Mobility Park



Jurong Community Hospital is the first community hospital designed and built from ground-up with regional hospital, Ng Teng Fong General Hospital. It provides post-acute and rehabilitative care for patients to transit them safely back into the community.

The Mobility Park at Jurong Community Hospital is an outdoor rehabilitative facility set in a lush garden purpose-built to provide patients with seamless and coordinated rehabilitation in a safe environment. A first of its kind in Singapore, it features a life-like simulated environment to patients.

A decommissioned taxi, low-floor bus mock-up and a life-sized mock-up of part of a train cabin was sponsored by SMRT Corporation Ltd to mirror familiar streetscapes. There is also a bus stop and waiting bay to help patients familiarise with the outdoor environment.

Patients and caregivers can learn to rehabilitate safely under the guidance of trained therapists to expand their mobility ranges, overcome barriers associated with riding the public transport, and use assistive aids such as the walking frame, crutches or wheelchairs to regain confidence to stay active and mobile after discharge.



Unique Features

- Life-sized public transport mock-ups comprising a bus, train cabin and taxi equipped with handicap and elderly-friendly features such as the wheelchair assistant button and a dedicated wheelchair access, help patients learn to get on and off the public transport safely.
- Simulated streetscapes that mirror the outdoors such as a pedestrian crossing, traffic light, walkways, ramps, stairs and the different terrains to familiarise patients with different environments to reintegrate back to the community.
- A sensory garden home to special herbs allows patients to look, touch and smell a variety of plants.


