HEALTH RISK WARNING (HRW)

Dear <Full Name> <Masked NRIC>,

You have been identified to have some risk of exposure to a COVID-19 case on <date of exposure>. On behalf of the Director of Medical Services, this SMS issues you with a 14-day Health Risk Warning (HRW) from <date of exposure> to <D14 of exposure>.

Under Section 55(1)(f) of the Infectious Disease Act (IDA), the Director of Medical Services / Health Officer requires you to undergo two Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) tests, one as soon as a slot is available, and the other on <D14 of exposure>.

Both of your PCR tests will be scheduled by MOH and instructions for your appointment will be sent shortly.

You will have to self-isolate until confirmation of a negative result from your first PCR test or until <D14 of exposure>, whichever is earlier.

You are also required to take a self-administered Antigen Rapid Test (ART) on <D7 of exposure>.

You are required to undergo the mandatory testing requirements outlined above, even if you had earlier come forward for a voluntary PCR test as part of MOH's community surveillance.
